Every scholar that completed the program will have their abstract published in the McNair Undergraduate Journal *Citations*.

**\*\*For full paper publication, follow the steps below.\*\***

## Steps for Submission

**1.** Submit the most up-to-date and most thoroughly revised copy of your paper to Aaron Walker at [mcnairsc@usc.edu](mailto:mcnairsc@usc.edu) by 5p.m. October 1st.

Revisions might include:

- Correcting unclear sentences, typos, structure, etc.
- Adding new insights from discussions with your faculty mentor
- Addition of the newest articles on the topic to your lit reviews
- Addressing issues raised in any of your conference presentations
- Addition of new results

**\*\*Don't forget to consult with your faculty advisors, SRI Instructors, and McNair Program Administrators for advice in the editing process**

**2.** A peer-review committee will read and return your paper and inform you of the status by October 15th. You will be informed whether your submission was “accepted,” “accepted with revisions,” or “rejected.”

**3.** Revised final papers should be submitted to [mcnairsc@usc.edu](mailto:mcnairsc@usc.edu) by 5p.m. October 28th.
